Day 1 – June 6, Sunday: Hold on to your seats—we’re headed for a trip through the Wild West! Today we stop in historic St. Joseph, MO, and visit the home of notorious outlaw **Jesse James**. We’ll learn the history of Jesse and how over the years his death has come under great scrutiny. And, of course, see the infamous bullet hole left in the wall where he met his fate. You’ve heard of the **Pony Express**? Well, now learn the history, how it got its start, what the riders went through, and the dangers of carrying the mail in the 1800s. We’ll overnight in the historic riverfront district of St Joseph.

Day 2- June 7, Monday: After a continental breakfast buffet we depart for that famous little town in Kansas, commonly known as Dodge City. In route to Dodge we will enjoy all the scenery that Kansas has to offer. **Dodge House Hotel**, listed on the National Register of Historic Hotels, is rich in history and reportedly where Wyatt Earp and his brothers frequented. Of course the Wild West had its fair share of gambling and you can catch the complimentary shuttle to experience the thrill of playing the hand you’ve been dealt, just like **Doc Holliday** and many other gunslingers. (Included meals – breakfast)



Day 3- June 8, Tuesday: Today after a hot breakfast buffet the **Mayor of Dodge City** will join us on the coach and tell the many stories and tales of the life and times of 18th Century Dodge. We visit the house of stone (known to be the oldest home in Dodge) and **Boot Hill cemetery** and museum where outlaws and undesirables are buried with their boots on. Ever wished you could walk the streets of Dodge and watch a **live gun fight** unfold in front of your eyes? Well, you will today! After you’ve spent time walking and shopping the streets of old Dodge City you’ll be ready to quench your thirst at the local saloon and belly up to the bar for a cold beer or their famous sarsaparilla. Tonight we dine at the Long Branch restaurant and enjoy a **dinner show**. After the show we return to the Dodge House to relax and unwind after a day in the Old West. (Included meals – breakfast and dinner)



Day 4- June 9 Wednesday: After a hot breakfast buffet we have a day of travel. Our destination is Tulsa and the famous Hard Rock Casino where we will have several options for dining including **Toby Keith’s I Love This Bar & Grill**. (Included meals – breakfast)



Day 5- June 10 Thursday: After the casino breakfast buffet we are joined by a step-on guide while in route to the **Will Rogers Museum**. We'll learn about the life of this famous western icon and movie star. Then we move on to the birth place of Will to view the historically restored home known as the **Dog Iron Ranch**. While at the ranch we will enjoy a traditional Cherokee lunch and be entertained by an interpretive actor and storyteller who will tell of the Cherokee Nation and Will Rogers. (Included meals – breakfast and lunch)
